



Speedcubing Ireland Competition Organiser Responsibilities

Organising a WCA competition is a large but rewarding responsibility. In Ireland, a competition can be organised by one or more individuals who partner with Speedcubing Ireland to plan and run a competition.

Anyone can organise a competition. Although having prior competition experience is helpful, Speedcubing Ireland is always interested in partnering with parents/guardians who have attended many competitions and are interested in organising a competition in their area. It is preferable that organisers are over the age of 16; those under 16 can organise but must complete a separate form and have parental approval.

If you are interested in organising a WCA competition, please review the summary of responsibilities below and read the WCA page on Organiser Responsibilities.

Organiser Responsibilities BEFORE the competition (some or all of these tasks may be carried out):

- Find a suitable venue and coordinate communication with the venue. Speedcubing Ireland will manage the financial aspect of this; we will pay deposits and, if required, may take over communication after a suitable venue has been found.
- Work with the Delegate(s) to complete the competition website, including developing the schedule and events.
- Attend and contribute to pre-competition meetings.
- Process registrations on the WCA website and, where appropriate, handle email correspondence and questions from the community regarding the competition on a timely basis.

Organiser Responsibilities DURING the competition:

- Arrive early and help with room and equipment setup (Delegate will provide equipment).
- Have someone available to check in/register competitors and pass out lanyards or other information as deemed necessary.
- Assist the delegate in monitoring timer displays for battery replacement.
- Help run/judge/scramble events when required.
- Ensure the competition runs on schedule by setting out scorecards for each event/group and calling out groups to come up and compete.
